#### **LINDA LEE REYNOLDS — TRYON, NC**

Linda Lee Reynolds moved to Tryon in 1992. She quickly became an integral member of the community. Linda Lee was the epitome of a strong southern woman- always stylish, definitely opinionated, a leader, and deeply involved in her community, especially the equestrian community. Her passions included supporting her daughter and her daughter's love for horses, gardening, bridge, singing, and enjoying life in general. Linda Lee was a founding member of the NCHJA, a member of the NC Horse Council, a board member of the NC School of Veterinary Medicine, a chairman of the TR&HC Charity Shows, a member of the Old Tryon Foot Beagles, President of the Community Chorus, President of the Tryon Historical Museum, a member of the Second Wind Hall of Fame, Chairman of the Presbyterian Women, and she played the bass in the Cigarette Holders Jazz Band. During her years serving as chairman of the TR&HC Summer Shows, her goal was to deliver shows that were special ... like the small boutique shows of days gone by, where hospitality ruled. Each night was a different themed exhibitors party, and with her connections she was able to find sponsors to keep costs down, making the shows not only more affordable, but also profitable. During those years the shows were often sold out; everyone wanted to come because everyone had fun- trainers, exhibitors, and spectators alike. Linda Lee gave so much to her community and has left a great legacy behind.
